Community Economic Development Program

The legal clinic is part of LSEM's <u>Community Economic Development Program</u>, which assists low income entrepreneurs and non-profits with basic legal needs of their organization. Eligible attendees may receive additional pro bono legal services arranged by LSEM.

The legal clinic took place at the Grace Hill <u>Water Tower Hub</u> located at 2125 Bissell Street, St. Louis, MO 63107, which was especially gratifying for the attorneys, as Capes Sokol serves as general counsel to Grace Hill and represented Grace Hill with respect to the development of the property, which opened in 2011.
