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On December 13, 2018, Sara G. Neill will present at the American Bar Association's 35th National Institute on Criminal Tax Fraud and 8th Annual National Institute on Tax Controversy.

Sara will participate as a panelist on the "Criminal Tax Workshop". This workshop will review the "nuts and bolts" of handling a criminal tax case, from notice of summons, a grand jury subpoena, or execution of a search warrant to a declination of prosecution, a plea or a trial.
