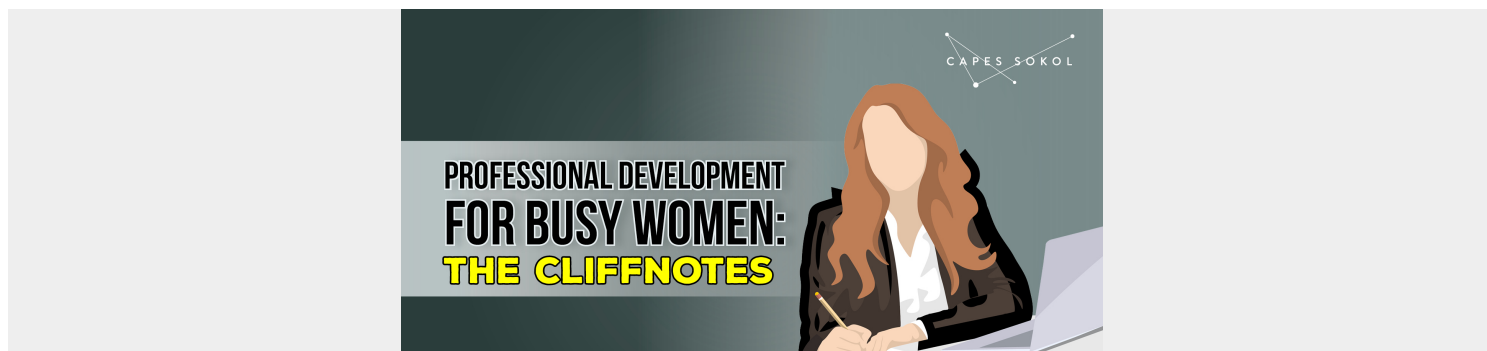


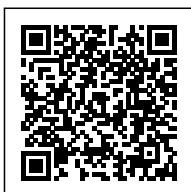
# SCHWERIN TO PRESENT AT MOCPA PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COURSE
