The Internal Revenue Service recently established the Office of Fraud Enforcement ("OFE") to enhance the detection and deterrence of fraudulent taxpayer activity. The OFE has broad authority to coordinate enforcement activity across all IRS activities, including cryptocurrency enforcement.
